TIGS private bus

Door to door, delivering your child to and from School safely, every day.

Our bus service offers peace of mind and convenience for busy families, especially those with young children or those who live off the beaten track. Our service runs from Stanwell to Nowra to Wilton and Appin, with expert and accredited drivers operating TIGS own private bus fleet. Charged per term, with zone pricing, you can avoid the morning rush for as little as \$13.00 per return trip.

Private Bus Agreement

Students using TIGS private buses will need to complete a code of conduct agreement, which outlines the safe and responsible behaviour expected while aboard. After hours bus service

Students often need to stay back after School. To get them home, we offer a free bus service operated by our Transportation team. This limited stop service departs from the Powell Street Car park at 5.00pm Monday to Thursday.

Train station transfers

Each morning and afternoon a bus transfer is available for students arriving at Wollongong train station. The walk from the station to school is approximately 30 minutes so bus transfer is advised.
