Criteria

Students will be considered for entry into the Podium Program based on their achievement level and training schedule. Sport selection in a school pathway or Olympic sport may take priority over a non-school pathway sport and may change from year to year. Selection is at the discretion of the Podium Committee.

Conditions of the Podium Program

The following Conditions must be read by the applicant and the applicant's parent/guardian and signed where indicated.

- Each student's position in the Podium Program will be reviewed annually.
- School representation is expected if the Podium sport is offered at the school level. The Podium Committee may grant an exemption.
- Students must behave responsibly and appropriately when representing The Illawarra Grammar School during public competitions or at any sporting function.
 - Students must not bring The Illawarra Grammar School or sport into disrepute through inappropriate actions or comments at any time.
- Students must uphold the ethos and values of the School when competing in sporting events.
- Students are expected to keep up with school work, attend recommended tutorials and complete any necessary documentation in a timely fashion.
- Gold Podium students must complete a Yearly Plan and submit it to the Podium Head Coach within four weeks of joining the program.
- Any academic problems need to be brought to the attention of the Head of Academic and Pastoral Care as soon as they emerge.
- School training commitments must be met.
- All relevant school functions must be attended, unless the Head of Senior School has granted leave.

Parents in the Podium Program also have responsibilities to uphold. They are required to:

- Behave responsibly and appropriately at sports and school functions.
- Not bring The Illawarra Grammar School or sport into disrepute through inappropriate actions/comments.
- Inform the School, through the Dean, of any issues associated with their child's academic performance or sporting commitment.
- Be loyal ambassadors of the School by supporting
 The Illawarra Grammar School community.

If at any time the conditions of The Illawarra Grammar School Podium Program are deemed in breach (by a parent/guardian or student), a review of the student's involvement in the Program will be conducted. I understand and accept these conditions.
